The Counseling Services Branch provides an array of services to assist service members and their families to transition from personal and family problems. Counseling, Advocacy, Treatment and Education are provided.



Our Services Include:

- **Screenings and Referrals** are provided by licensed counselors and are available on a walk-in basis from 1300 to 1500 Monday through Friday.
- **Counseling** is available to individuals and couples with priority given to active duty. We also offer:
 - Combat Stress Group
 - Combat Stress Workshop
- **Family Advocacy Program (FAP)** services are provided to individuals and/or families involved with family violence or sexual assault.
 - **Victim Advocates** provide direct services to victims of spouse abuse or sexual assault and are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
 - **FAP Groups** are available by referral and are designed to assist individuals and couples improve and enrich their personal lives.
 - Men's Education Group
 - Women's Education Group
 - Domestic Violence Support Group
 - POWER Workshop

- **Prevention and Education** offers classes and workshops are offered to help individuals learn to identify power and control struggles in their relationships and develop healthy alternatives to conflict resolution.

- Stress Management
- Anger Management
- Conflict Resolution
- Couples Communication

- **Command Education** is available to assist the leadership with various training's, briefings , and workshops to aid in the early detection of problems so they can be resolved before they become readiness obstacles.
