1. Situation. To publish information concerning the 2009 Pendleton Cup Intramural Sports Program.

2. Mission. The Intramural Sports Program provides active duty personnel, stationed at Camp Pendleton, regardless of skill or experience, an opportunity to take part in a competitive unit sports program. This program helps promote combat readiness, esprit de corps, leadership, teamwork, and loyalty. This program helps identify and enable athletes with exceptional skills to continue on to higher levels of competition. Sports have been chosen to promote democratic competitions emphasizing physical fitness and a balanced program.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent

(a) The 2009 Pendleton Cup Program will be broken into two halves. The first half will begin in January and will conclude in May. The second half will begin in June, concluding in November. (See enclosure (1))

(b) The Pendleton cup points and Division Placements are listed in enclosures (2) and (3).

(c) Both halves of the 2009 Pendleton Cup Program will award each of the winning battalions with a Pendleton Cup Trophy, in addition to monetary compensation in the form of Commanders' Recreation Funds. These funds will be given to 1st through 3rd place in each division in June and November of 2009. The division and monetary breakdown for each half will be as follows:

Placement Points: Placement points are given to 1st-3rd places in each division. Points will also be given for the 1st-3rd playoff winners in each league (second number given in league placement standings). It is possible for a battalion to earn all placement points.

Entry Points: Entry points are given to the first participant from each battalion, additional entry points are given up to the 10th participant from the same battalion, with the following exception: when different categories are offered within a sport (i.e., weight classes, age classes). A battalion may receive entry points for each category entered.
