SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME (SSI) & Special Needs Trust

SSI makes monthly payments to people with low income and limited resources who are 65 or older, or blind or disabled. Your child younger than 18 can qualify if he or she meets Social Security's definition of disability for children, and if his or her income and resources fall within the eligibility limits. The amount is the same for all 50 states for the Federal amount; however, each state can allocate a Food portion either via a check or debit card. The total amount of SSI across the board is \$889.40. Instead of leaving assets directly to a disabled child, a Special Needs Trust could be created. Please come to review information!
