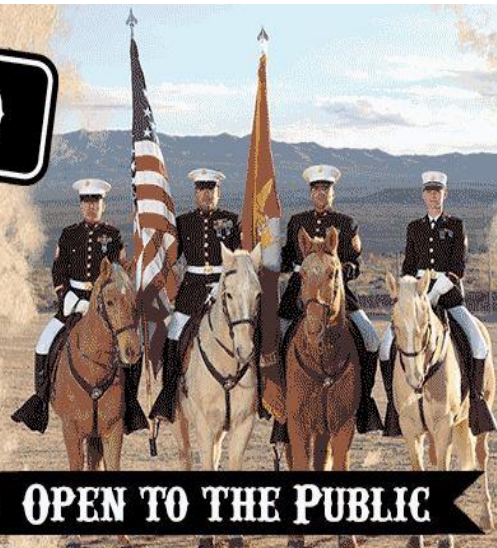





Victor Rivas Rivers is a nationally recognized actor, author and domestic violence activist.

Rivers tells the heartbreaking and ultimately triumphant story of his escape from what he calls the "war zone" of family violence. Rivers, at the age of 12, covered in burns, bruises, and welts, sought help from law enforcement. He told them that this was also happening to his mom and his siblings, but was turned away because it was then seen as a "private family matter."

Domestic Violence is much more than a private family matter, it is a worldwide epidemic. In this presentation, Rivers educates and inspires by sharing his story, on how domestic violence can happen anywhere, and how we must all stand together to stop it.
