

KEELBOAT/CRUISING

Now that you have learned the basics of sailing, a new adventure awaits you in the ocean. It is time to move up and experience sailing off the Southern California coast where dolphins, sea lions, and whales play. This course is set up for those who have completed the Learn to Sail course. This course will cover the skills to day sail in the ocean, and coastal cruise along the coast. It will cover: sail trim, anchoring, VHF radio operations, reefing, outboard motors, docking, crew overboard, weather, basic charting, how to fly a spinnaker, and other sailing skills. You will be heading out to sea the first day of class! This is a 4- day class, 8 hours each day, Sat.-Sun. X2, with a great mix of class instruction and practical sailing on the water. Books used for this course are US SAILING Basic Keelboat and Basic Cruising, these are included in course fees. Classes taught on a Catalina 22 sailboats. At the completion of this course, you will receive your US Sailing Keelboat certification, logbook and year membership with US Sailing. You also will be qualified to rent these boats for day sailing along our coast, and go cruising with us as a fleet to Dana Point!
