

SEAMANSHIP



This class is designed to get you ready to go to both Dana Point and Mission Bay by yourself. You will be instructed on several new skills; GPS, Mooring, Coastal Weather, Sail Trim, Piloting, and Trip Planning. This class will also reinforce the skills you learned in the Keelboat/Cruising Class: Anchoring, Docking, COB, and Reefing. You can use this class to fine-tune your skills, so you may become a more seasoned sailor. Since this class is only 2-days there will be some prep in advance, so please plan to sign up no later than a week prior to start.

The practical element to this class is a cruise to Mission Bay; if you are looking to sail off station on your own. The instructor will be evaluating you while you demonstrate the skills learned in the class. Please beware you will need to secure a crew for yourself for this cruise. This is separate from the class, and has separate fees. On the cruise you will be anchoring in Mariner's cove, and spending a wonderful evening out on the water; the boats will raft up and share sea stories and more.

The class is held on Catalina 27's with an instructor/evaluator on board. (You do not need to be qualified to sail 27's to do this class) This is a 2-day class over a weekend.

Need to sign up in advance for course there is some prep work sent to you by the instructor.

Prerequisite is to have completed the Keelboat/Cruising class and have sailed a minimum of 8 hours in ocean
