

SAILBOATS

The Marina has a large fleet of sailboats ranging from 12.5' to 30' that are used for classes, rentals, cruises, races, regattas, and charters. All of our sailboats 22' and up can head out to the ocean, which is only 10 min from our docks, for day sailing. We have a wonderful coastline to explore with whales that migrate back and forth in the winter and spring time. The Blue whales can be seen on occasion throughout the year along with a variety of dolphins that feed and play off our coast. We also host wonderful cruises that will have you experiencing other ports up and down the coastline. Although some of these cruises are set up for students that have completed our Keelboat/Cruising or Seamanship courses you can join them if you are already certified to rent our vessels. This is a great way to experience coastal cruising sailing as beginners with an escort boat. We pride ourselves on having the best maintained fleet of boats that are in the water ready to go. You do need to have certifications and do practical sail if you have not gone through our courses, but if you have a certification or rental card from another facility. Reservations will need to be made to complete the practical check out.

Please make sure you read the Marina rules, before you head down it has information about different qualifications needed to rent, what you can bring, capacity on the different boats, boundaries and so much more.



HARBOR SAILBOATS

Our Expo 12.5 and Capri. 16.5 are harbor only sailboats that can travel out to the outer basin. They are both easy to rig and offer lots of fun sailing. These boats don't have motors you will sail away from the dock and back in using the sails.


EXPO 12.5

This is a great boat for solo sailors, or for qualified youth sailors, 10 years of age and up, to bring a friend out on. It is great in all wind conditions, especially anything over 10 knots; they have some zip to them. The Expo's are set up with a roller mainsail for easy reefing, a dagger board, and a wide deck to sit on. We use these boats for our youth classes, rentals, races, and for our capsize drills. We have 8 of these vessels, however during the winter we only have 4 in the water.



CAPRI 16.5

This boat is amazing. It is a great boat for solo sailing or sailing with others; 4 people max. It has a large mainsail, small roller furling jib, and a 250 lbs. fixed keel that draws 3 ft., as well as, a mainsail that can be reefed if needed. We have 8 of these sailboats in our fleet that we use them in our, Learn to Sail Course, rentals, regattas, and races. Also, sailors ages 16 and up can rent these with certification.



OCEAN SAILBOATS

We have a variety of sailboats that can head out to the ocean ranging from 22'-30' that are all well maintained and fully equipped with all the requirements and so much more: VHF radios, outboard, and inboard engines, rod holders, coolers, porta potties, 30 amp shore power and 12V batteries. Cruising spinnakers and GPS's are also available for rental. You can sail out as far as you want as long as you are back to the dock by the required time. The boats do require certifications and check out so please call in advance to secure a rental card from our facility. All of our ocean going sailboats require a minimum of 2 people, one certified and the second must be at least 16 years old. Come join us and explore the Pacific for some great sailing along the So. California Coast.

CATALINA 22's



This a great boat. I call it the Pocket Rocket because it is super-fast, has a 6-hp. outboard engine, a great sail plan, and is great for day sailing or cruising along the coast. We carry Genoa's on them that you can roll up to a jib, and mainsails that are set up to be reefed if needed. These vessels have enough room for up to 5 people max, have some storage under the bunks for sleeping, and a small table that can be folded down. We have 5 in our fleet that are used for rentals, cruises, and in our Keelboat/Cruising Course.

CATALINA 250's



This is a good boat to take out in light to moderate winds and are super popular because of the high seats in the back. Since has a lot of freeboard it has lots of room below decks with a table and large aft bunk. These vessels have a 9.9 hp. outboard, roller furling jib and large mainsail that you can reef when needed, and a head on board. It can take up to 6 people total, and we have 3 in our fleet. They are used in our rental fleet, charters and cruises.

CATALINA 27's



These are great sailboats have a perfect sail plan for sailing in So California. They are very stiff boats that can sail in just about any conditions. Ours are tiller versions with 9.9 outboards with electric tilt and start, we also have 1 with an inboard diesel engine. They have a nice cabin inside with head room, sleeping quarters and a head. We carry roller furling Genoa's on ours, and the mainsail is set up to reef when needed. The 27's are really fun boats to sail up and down the coast and can hold up to 6 people total. We have 3 in our fleet and used for rentals, cruises, charters, and the Seamanship Course.

NEWPORT 30's

These are the largest boats we rent out. They are super stiff boats, but they can handle any conditions. They both have wheel steering and inboard diesel engines. They have a nice cabin inside with head room, sleeping quarters, head and refrigeration. We carry roller furling Genoa's on them, and the mainsail is set up to reef when needed. Our Newport 30's are fun sailboats that can take up to 6 people out for coastal cruising. We have two in our fleet that used for rentals, cruises, and charters.
